**STATEMENT ON THE GOVERNOR'S SIGNING OF NET
NEUTRALITY LEGISLATION**

SACRAMENTO - The California Cable and Telecommunications Association (CCTA) put out the following statement today, following the Governor's signing of Net Neutrality legislation SB 822 (Wiener):

"CCTA and its members are committed to an open internet, but this legislation is unlawful and will harm consumers. Trying to regulate the internet through a patchwork of state and local legislation is incredibly shortsighted, and will result in regulatory uncertainty that will hurt innovation and investment, while raising costs for customers in California for years to come. This extreme law – which flouts and conflicts with clear federal laws and policy – will almost certainly face challenges in court, which is why our members support comprehensive federal legislation that will provide certainty for all U.S. customers, without favoring some internet companies over others."
